



Procedures for Psychologist of the Day

The Psychologist of the Day serves on Mondays every week during legislative session. The psychologist is introduced in the House and Senate with Monday sessions usually starting at 1 p.m. Professional dress is expected as this is how all Capitol elected leaders and their staff dress.

The psychologist should report to medical office (Doctor of the Day) which is now located on the ground floor of the Capitol building by the snack shop and gift shop. The Psychologist of the Day should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of session. Session generally starts at 1:30 p.m. but Danna Fowble, Executive Director will communicate and confirm the start time, the Friday prior. Susan Hollingsworth will escort you to the House Chambers.

The psychologist of the day will park in the east lot and the Sergeant of Arms, parked in a grey HOR van, will direct the Psychologist of the day to their parking space. This year, there is quite a bit of construction, so allow enough time for that

New this year, OPA staff will assist you with making appointments with your House and Senate leaders or any other legislators you have relationships with, if that helps. We also provide you with information in advance and a phone conversation with our lobbyist prior can always be arranged.

We really appreciate you arriving as early as possible before session begins. And, it will be very helpful to the practice of psychology if appointments with your House and Senate leaders can be arranged, PRIOR to the start of session at 1 p.m.
